The Dalton, Georgia based company recycles and reconditions intermediate bulk containers (IBCs), poly drums and a wide variety of plastic materials. The firm will sell reconditioned intermediate bulk containers, rebottled IBCs and reconditioned poly drums. At the Gastonia location the operation will be set up to receive used IBCs, poly drums, steel drums and other types of plastic materials from regional industries. IMACC Corporation has been a member of the Reusable Industrial Packaging Association since 1999.
